 Empower the caregiver become an advocate for their own needs and those of the care receiver

 Connect caregivers to a larger community of support



Caregiver Services/Supports Specialist: My Role

- Information & Referral
- Caregiver counseling
- Caregiver education

Provide ongoing connection & support as needed

Caregiver Services/Supports Specialist: My Role

Information & Referral: A broad term that relates to speaking with caregivers or family members of caregivers and providing **counseling**

- ✓ Listen/ask lots of questions/learn
- ✓ Assess needs and prioritize
 - Immediate needs
 - Long-term needs
- ✓ Help devise a plan: includes providing referrals to assist and linking them to services at the County and across service systems
