FOR EXAMPLE:

A client with a disability lived in his apartment for 12 years and was quarantining due to COVID. He was unable to pay rent due to COVID-related loss of income. His landlord sent him notices, threatening to declare his apartment abandoned in order to make him move. VLPCNY was able to reach out to the landlord, and their attorney, to assert the client's rights as a tenant and avoid an illegal eviction by the landlord.
